5.1 Purchase of Threshfield Old Railway Line- update from Cllr Clarke, grant from Tarmac extended. Monies received from Yorventure.. An agreed restriction included in title deed the land is for public use and cannot be disposed of without approval of National Park. Solicitor has applied to Land Registry for the restriction to be included.

5.2 Flooding B6160 near Long Ashes- update via clerk, gullies to be cleaned in interim. Long term solution being agreed.

5.3 Lighting issues, update from Cllr Bradley & clerk, 3 lights still need repairing. Tree obstructing one. Clerk to report again on Highways Portal.

5.4 Potholes- update from clerk. Members of public reported several potholes: footpath on Caxton Garth, potholes near Manor Farm, Moor Road, & Caxton Garth entrance. Clerk to report all to Highways Portal.
